Every Friday afternoon during the summer our downtown main street brims with crafts, produce, meat, herbs and baked goods piled high in baskets with shoppers and growers in lively conversation. The Laramie community and surrounding area flock to the market generating revenue that supports the vendors as well as introducing and or bringing our community into our downtown area to shop.

Raw and value-added agriculture, prepared foods, crafts and services are all considered for vending. Junior High and High School students are invited to submit a one page resume with business plan. A onetime deposit fee of \$15.00 will be submitted with entry. This fee is returned when the vendor completes the day/s they have chosen to vend. It is forfeited for no-shows. This program will accept vendors that offer products or services that are suitable for market. A 10x10 space (with tent if needed) will be provided. Vendors must follow standard rules and regulations in addition to:

- 1. Applicant must be a student in Junior High or High School.
- 2. Products/services will not be duplicated. Example: If a vendor has been accepted on a particular day to sell knitted caps another vendor will not be accepted for the same product on that day.
- 3. Application will include one page resume with description of product or service.
- 4. Vendor will provide table, chairs, and any necessary equipment to vend. All vendors are required to have a tent. DLBA will provide a tent with advance notice (if needed).
